

1. Terms of Use — DocCount

Last updated: 1 December 2025

1. Who is behind DocCount

DocCount is an online application that helps independent healthcare contractors and other professionals track their consultations and earnings.

DocCount is operated by:

Sergio Damián Capdevila

(acting as an individual, not through a company)

contact@damiancapdevila.com

In these Terms, “**DocCount**”, “**we**”, “**us**” and “**our**” refer to Sergio Damián Capdevila. “**You**” and “**your**” refer to you as a user of DocCount.

By accessing or using DocCount, including signing in or creating an account, you agree to be bound by these Terms of Use.

If you do not agree, you must not use DocCount.

2. Description of the Service

DocCount currently provides:

- A **sandbox mode** (no login required) where you can try the app and store data locally in your browser.
- An **authenticated mode** where your data is stored in our database (via Supabase) and can sync across devices.
- Features including (but not limited to):
 - Tracking per-category consultations and earnings.
 - Tracking total working time and derived earnings.
 - A dashboard showing daily and monthly earnings based on your usage.

DocCount is an evolving product. We may add, change or remove features at any time.

3. Eligibility

To use DocCount you must:

- Be at least 18 years old.
- Have legal capacity to enter into a contract under the laws of your country.
- Use the service only for lawful purposes.

If you use DocCount on behalf of another person or organization, you confirm that you are authorized to bind them to these Terms.

4. Account, Access and Security

- You can test DocCount in **sandbox mode** without an account. Data in this mode is stored **locally** in your browser and is your sole responsibility.
- To save data across devices you must **sign in** (for example using email Magic Link or Google).
- You are responsible for:
 - Keeping your login credentials secure.
 - All activity that occurs under your account.
- If you suspect unauthorized access, you must notify us as soon as reasonably possible.

We may suspend or terminate your access if we reasonably believe that your account is being misused, compromised, or used in violation of these Terms or applicable law.

5. Acceptable Use

You agree **not** to:

1. Attempt to access data belonging to other users.
2. Interfere with or disrupt the service, servers, or networks.
3. Attempt to bypass security measures or rate limits.
4. Use DocCount to store or process:
 - Illegal content, or
 - Special categories of personal data (e.g. health data, racial or ethnic data) beyond what is strictly necessary to track your activity (e.g. category names you define yourself).
5. Reverse-engineer, decompile, or attempt to extract the source code of DocCount, except where permitted by law.
6. Use DocCount to build a competing service by scraping or copying its look-and-feel in a misleading way.

We may investigate and take action (including account suspension) if we suspect a breach of this section.

6. No Professional Advice

DocCount is a **tracking and productivity tool**. It does **not** provide:

- Tax, accounting, legal, or financial advice.
- Medical or clinical advice.
- Any form of professional or regulated advice.

Any numbers, reports, or charts you see in DocCount are based entirely on the data you enter. You are responsible for checking the correctness of your data and for how you use it (e.g. with tax authorities, clients, or employers).

7. Availability and Modifications

We aim to keep DocCount available and working, but:

- We do not guarantee **uninterrupted** or **error-free** service.
- We may temporarily suspend or limit access:
 - For maintenance, upgrades, or security reasons.
 - Due to failures of external providers (e.g. hosting, database).

We may modify or discontinue parts of the service. Where changes are significant, we will make reasonable efforts to inform you in advance (e.g. via in-app notice or email).

8. Data and Privacy

Your use of DocCount is also governed by our **Privacy Policy**, which explains:

- What personal data we collect.
- How we use and share it.
- Your rights under GDPR and Spanish law.

By using DocCount, you acknowledge that you have read our Privacy Policy.

9. Intellectual Property

- The DocCount app, its design, code, and branding are owned by or licensed to Sergio Damián Capdevila.
- You are granted a **limited, non-exclusive, revocable, non-transferable license** to use DocCount solely for your own business or personal use.
- You may not:

- Copy, distribute, or modify the app's code or design except as permitted by law.
- Use the DocCount name or branding in a way that suggests endorsement or affiliation without written permission.

You retain all rights to the **data you input** into DocCount (e.g. your categories, counts, and earnings).

10. Third-Party Services

DocCount relies on third-party services, for example:

- **Supabase** for authentication and database.
- **Vercel** for hosting.
- **Resend** for transactional email.
- Analytics providers (e.g. Vercel Analytics).

These providers have their own terms and privacy practices. We only share data with them to the extent necessary to provide DocCount, as described in the Privacy Policy.

11. Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law:

- DocCount is provided on an “**as is**” and “**as available**” basis.
- We do NOT guarantee:
 - That DocCount is free from errors, bugs, or security vulnerabilities.
 - That DocCount will meet all of your specific needs.
- We are **not liable** for:
 - Any indirect, incidental, consequential, or special damages.

- Any loss of profits, revenue, data, or goodwill.
- Any issues caused by third-party services.

Our total cumulative liability for any claim arising out of or relating to DocCount or these Terms will be limited to **the greater of**:

1. The amount (if any) you paid us in the 12 months immediately preceding the event giving rise to the claim; or
2. One hundred (100) euros.

Nothing in these Terms excludes or limits liability where such exclusion or limitation is not permitted by law (for example, in cases of fraud or willful misconduct).

12. Indemnification

You agree to indemnify and hold harmless Sergio Damián Capdevila from and against any claims, damages, liabilities, and expenses (including reasonable legal fees) arising out of:

- Your misuse of DocCount.
 - Your breach of these Terms.
 - Your violation of any law or third-party rights in connection with your use of DocCount.

13. Changes to These Terms

We may update these Terms from time to time, for example when we:

- Add or change features;
- Change our business model; or
- Need to comply with new laws.

When we make changes we will:

- Update the “Last updated” date at the top, and
- Provide reasonable notice (e.g. via in-app banner or email, where possible).

If you continue using DocCount after the new Terms become effective, you will be deemed to have accepted the changes.

14. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

These Terms are governed by **Spanish law**, without regard to conflict of laws rules.

Any disputes arising out of or relating to these Terms or your use of DocCount will be submitted to the **competent courts in Spain**, unless mandatory law requires otherwise.
